

NOTICE OF SOLICITATION TO BID

Sealed proposals will be received at the office of the Tahoe-Truckee Sanitation Agency, located at Tahoe-Truckee Sanitation Agency, 13720 Butterfield Drive, Truckee, CA 96161, until 2:00 P.M. local time on the 16th day of June, 2022, or such later date as may be set by addendum, and then will be publicly opened and read for the construction of the following public works project:

2022 DIGITAL SCANNING OF SEWER LINES

The proposed work consists of the following:

Digital scanning of three (3) sections of the Tahoe-Truckee Sanitation Agency's gravity sewer interceptor Schedules I, II, and III along the Truckee River corridor between Tahoe City, CA and Truckee, CA. Deliver high quality, three-dimensional, panoramic digital scanning and viewing software to provide virtual desktop inspections of the interceptor from any perspective. Pipeline sections consist of 24", 27", 30", 33", and 36" reinforced concrete pipe and 24" and 30" ductile iron pipe, approximately 37,100 linear feet.

The contract documents for the Project, including the public works construction contract, instructions to bidders, bid forms, and plans and specifications, may be examined at the Agency office, with prior notice to the Agency's representative, located at 13720 Butterfield Drive, Truckee, California 96161. An electronic copy of the contract documents may be obtained upon request free of charge. Alternatively, a printed copy of contract documents may be obtained at the Agency's office upon request and payment of \$35. This payment is non-refundable. Bidders must comply with the Instructions to Bidders.

The Agency will hold a mandatory virtual pre-bid conference at 10:00 A.M. on Tuesday, June 7th, 2022. Instructions on how to attend this virtual meeting will be given to all registered planholders. It is suggested that each prospective bidder review the bid documents and project site prior to the pre-bid conference. Each prospective bidder shall be required to attend the pre-bid conference. Bids from any bidder not attending this conference will be rejected as non-responsive.

Review of the project sites is an opportunity for bidders to assess existing conditions, confirm estimated quantities and scope of work, perform all measurements, and conduct field investigations necessary for proper Bid preparation. Failure to perform these activities shall not be a basis for claims related to assessing existing conditions and constraints and performing all verifications.

Each Bid must be submitted on the prescribed forms and accompanied by cash, a cashier's check, certified check or bid bond executed on the prescribed form payable to the Agency in an amount not less than 10 percent of the amount bid.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a payment bond and faithful performance bond each in the full amount of the Contract price, and insurance with certificates and endorsements of insurance, as provided in the Contract Documents. The required bonds must be provided only by a surety insurer who is admitted to do business by and in good standing with the California Department of Insurance.

Bidders are hereby notified that in accordance with Public Contract Code section 22300, securities may be substituted for any monies that the Agency may withhold pursuant to the terms of this Contract to ensure performance.

The successful bidder must possess the following classification or type of contractor's license issued by the Contractors State License Board: Class A, C-36, or C-42.

To be qualified to bid on this Project, bidders must be registered and qualified to perform public work with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant section 1725.5 of the Labor Code. All subcontractors listed in a qualified bidder's bid as performing any portion of the work also must be registered and qualified with the Department of Industrial Relations.

Bids that equal or exceed \$1,000,000 must be accompanied by an Iran Contracting Act certification in the form provided in section 1.9.

The attention of bidders is directed to the requirements and conditions of employment to be observed and prevailing wage rates to be paid to all workers employed under the Contract in accordance with Labor Code sections 1770 and following. Copies of the prevailing rate of per diem wages are on file at the Agency's office and will be made available to any interested party on request. In accordance with Labor Code section 1771.4(a)(1), this project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

The Agency reserves the right to reject all bids. Any bid not conforming to the intent and purpose of the Contract Documents may be rejected. The Agency may extend the time to award the Contract. The Work shall be performed during the period between September 6th, 2022 through October 14th, 2022.
